A Suddenlink representative will respond within 10 days of receiving this form. If the dispute is not resolved to your satisfaction within thirty (30) days of Suddenlink's receipt of the dispute, you may begin arbitration by submitting a Demand for Arbitration to the American Arbitration Association ("AAA").
